He will then raise the wicked (the "second resurrection"), who will surround the New Jerusalem lead by [Satan](#). The Bible does not support a "hell" as a place of conscious eternal punishment. Finally, God will create a new earth where the redeemed will enjoy eternal life **free of sin** and suffering.
