## **WATER FROM A ROCK**

With a correct understanding of Scripture ~ we can stand firm on the truth that there is no hopeless situation, unless we choose to become a hopeless person. Think with me about Moses as he can teach us a powerful lesson concerning God's unlimited abilities and love for His children.

With God's help, Moses faced the mighty Pharaoh to lead the children of Israel out of Egypt. Even through 40 years in the desert, he stood fast in his faithfulness. In that vast, harsh wilderness, Moses looked to God to provide the needs of all the people. But, a constant problem was the scarcity of food and water, especially for the number of people he was leading.

Through the mercies of God, the desert holds many life-giving resources. For example, every year thousands of quail migrate south from Turkey across the Mediterranean to the coast of North Africa. Exhausted from their flight, the quail fall to the desert sand and it was a simple task for God's children to gather them. The timing and large number of quail demonstrate God's supernatural power as "Provider" [please see Num 11:31].

The limitless mercies of God also allow the desert to provide water for the experienced traveler. The large, black granite mountains rising sharply from the desert floor hide reservoirs of water within their walls. Rainfall seeps into the mountain crevices and is trapped in the porous limestone running through the granite cliffs. One sharp blow of a staff to the limestone brings forth a stream of refreshing water.

Moses knew of this practice ... yet ... God asked Moses to perform the uncommon. God told Moses to go and speak to the rock. Accustomed to hitting the rock, Moses failed to recognize God's unlimited abilities. Moses was so skilled in the "ordinary" that he didn't see God's power at work. He expected God to provide the water for that vast number of people in the ordinary way. But sometimes ... God wants to do the extraordinary!

God's plan for our lives may include extraordinary opportunities. My the Holy Spirit keep us from becoming so accustomed to the "comman" that we lack faith in God's ability to do the uncommon. Let's prayerfully be open to the possibility of God doing the impossible in our lives ~~ something that would bring glory to His name and enhance His Kingdom!
