## WE ALL CAN SERVE

This week I want to talk to those of you who aren't often called upon to be "up front." Please consider **Mark 14:13**: "*So He sent out two of His disciples and said to them, 'Go into the city, and a man will meet you carrying a pitcher of water; follow him.'*" Here's the bottom line ~~ we need to be prepared to do the uncommon when God calls us. In the above verse, that exactly what the man with the pitcher did.

During the week before Jesus' crucifixion, He called Peter and John and instructed them to go into Jerusalem to prepare the Passover meal. There they'd see a man carrying a pitcher. They were to follow him as he led them to the room where Jesus would eat the Last Supper with His disciples.

In the cultural society of the New Testament, it was most common to see a woman (not a man) carrying a jar or pitcher of water. The Bible shares nothing more about the man whom God instructed to carry the pitcher of water. But from the culture and time we do know that he was asked to do something out of the ordinary. Yet his call from God was clear and he carried out his task. And by doing so he served the Son of God and His disciples by leading them to the room where they'd share their last meal together during Jesus' earthly ministry.

By faithfully following God's call, the man with the pitcher served Jesus in a unique way. He was a "man behind the scenes" in a significant event in the ministry of Jesus. So, when God calls you with certainty to perform a task that is uncommon or unusual ... we need to do it with total commitment ... for we'll never know when we'll be serving God in a special way. When you cooperate with God, He'll take the ordinary out of your life and make it extraordinary ... for His glory
